Conditions:

- *Homestay service only available for student age 12+
- *Students are required to hold an Australian mobile phone number
- *Course Fees included Enrolment fee, course fee, material fee, weekend activities fee, T-shirt and a GoCard
- *Arrival to homestay and departure from homestay is Sunday to Sunday (to join the Saturday activity)
- *For students who start the program on 19 January, Homestay service is available from 17 January 2026. Students who finish on 14 February, Homestay service available to 15 February 2026
- *It is compulsory for all Under 18 students staying with Langports Homestay Family to book a return airport transfer (Pick-up + Drop-Off)
- *All meals covered
- *Langports accommodations are not available for parents
- *During the peak season, Homestay may host more than one student, placements with similar backgrounds may occur when necessary
- *Arrivals after 8pm and before 6am will incur a \$200 late night surcharge for the transfer and for the family to welcome them late at night
- *A guardian/parent per a student
- *Total enrolment weeks must be same or less the enrolment weeks of child
