Program Highlights

- ✓ The program includes Australian High School-style academic assessments, covering writing, presentations, reading, and group workshops.
- ✓ The daily schedule consists of four hours of intensive English classes and one hour of academic or sports activities.
- ✓ A full-day excursion is held every Saturday to explore local attractions and cultural experiences.
- ✓ Availability is limited to only 20 students per intake to ensure a personalised experience.

Conditions

- *Students must enrol for a minimum of one week.
- *Course Fees included Enrolment fee, course fee, material fee, weekend activities fee, T-shirt and a GoCard.
- *Homestay check-in and check-out: Sunday to Sunday (to join Saturday activity).
- *Langports accommodations are not available for parents.
- *During peak season, homestay families may host multiple students, sometimes with similar backgrounds.
- *Arrivals after 8PM or before 6AM incur a \$200 surcharge for late-night transfer and family welcome.
- *Students must arrive with an active mobile connection.
- *Bring a debit card, credit card, or Wise card for daily expenses, as Langports is a cashless school.


