1. Assessment: "Controllable Level"

- **Objective Metrics:** Even when including all symptomatic patients regardless of severity, the peak prevalence rate remains at approximately **10%** of the total capacity.
- **Medical Expert Opinion:** Compared to typical mass infection cases, the current situation is assessed to be within a **controllable range** rather than a critical stage.
- **Strategic Direction:** To alleviate psychological anxiety, the school will continue to share data based on the "ratio relative to the total population" rather than vague figures.

2. Current Status of Personalized Medical Response

- **Severe Cases:** Patients with severe symptoms are undergoing blood tests followed by intensive treatment and management through **external hospital admission**.
- **Mild Cases:** Patients are receiving prescriptions and are being monitored; the majority of these students are currently showing **signs of improvement**.

3. Strengthening the Medical System

To improve the quality of patient care, we are extending clinic hours from the current 1 hour to **3 hours**. (The schedule is subject to change upon mutual agreement.)

- **New Schedule:** 09:30 - 12:30 (In-person) + 1 additional hour of online consultation.
- **Expected Benefits:** Significantly reduced waiting times and the ability to provide more detailed, personalized treatment for every student.

4. Partnership and Security Reinforcement

- **Collaboration:** The medical team deeply empathizes with the academy's situation and has pledged their active cooperation and support for all future health management protocols.
