English lessons



Lessons schedule: 9:00AM to 12:55PM, Monday to Friday (lessons can also be taught in the afternoon).



Academic: The focus of lessons will mainly be on speaking, listening, vocabulary and pronunciation skills, with some emphasis on grammar, reading, and writing.



Materials: Notepad/paper and pen needed. Study materials are provided. Wi-Fi is available in the school.

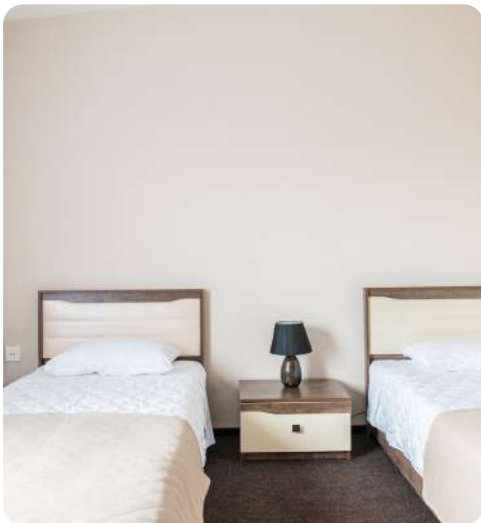


LSI Certificate: LSI certificate on completion of the programme.



Class size: 16 student maximum.

Accommodation and meals



Accommodation in homestay families are **single rooms (very few twin room options available) with shared bathrooms**. Each room includes a bed, a desk, a table and storage space for clothing. Bed linens and towels are provided. Laundry facilities are available in all of our homestays (washing detergent is not included) and Wi-Fi is available for students to use.

Curfew is at 10:00pm every evening for all students unless supervised on an LSI activity. (For 12 - 16, curfew is set at 6pm)

Breakfast is provided by the host and typically includes: cereal, toast, fruit, juice and tea or coffee. For lunch, hosts will provide a packed lunch which usually includes: a sandwich or a salad, crisps and a fruit. For dinner, students will receive a cooked meal in their homestays in the evenings.

Students must advise LSI at the time of booking of any dietary requirements. There is an additional fee for dairy, gluten free, and/or nut free diets.

Transport



Auckland Airport:
30 minutes away from LSI Auckland

Transfer Service: We suggest booking an LSI transfer to ensure a safe transfer to their accommodation.

For individual students aged 18 or under, airport transport services are compulsory.

Travelling to School: Our homestays are within an easy commute from school. Upon arrival, the homestay host will provide instructions on how to reach the school.

Travelling to Activities: Students will meet our activity leaders at the school and travel together. We will ensure they are on the correct bus home.

Travel card: Travel cards are not included; it is advisable for students to buy an unlimited weekly bus pass individually or at the school.

Why Auckland?

Situated on New Zealand's North Island, Auckland is not only the largest city in the country but also one of the most beautiful. With beaches, harbours, and mountains all within easy reach, it offers stunning natural surroundings. Upon arrival, host family welcomes the student, shows them their room, and explains how to reach the school.

Groups with students aged **12-13** are placed in closed groups and groups with students aged **14-17** are placed according to their English level.
