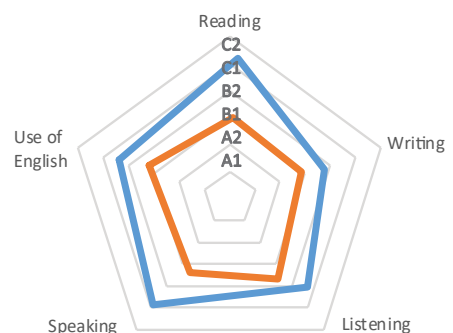

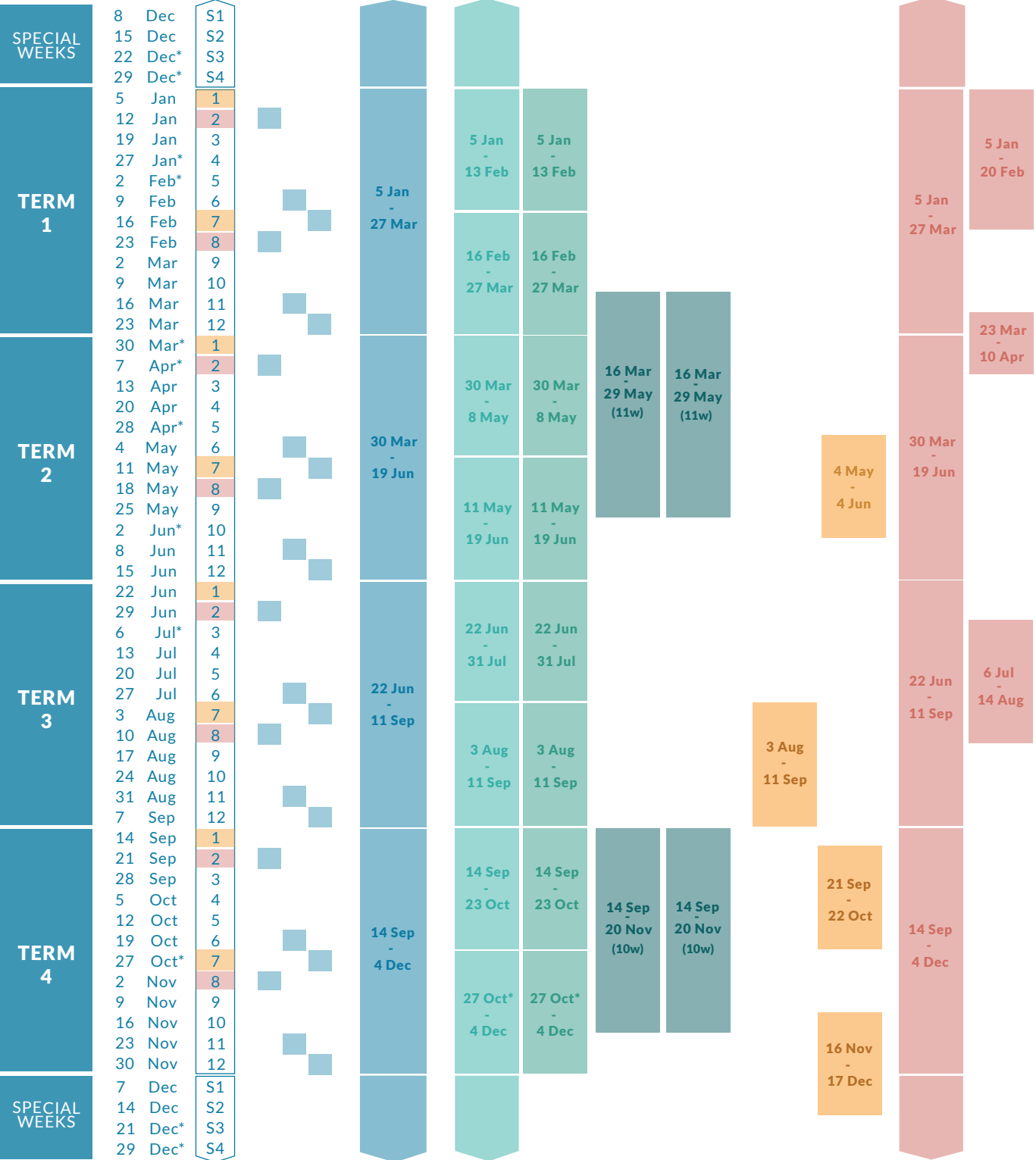
## Progress Report Diagram

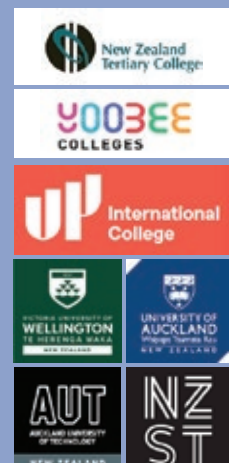

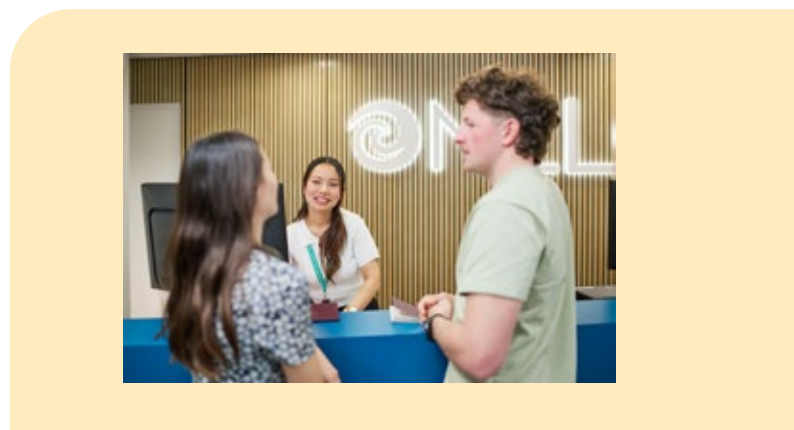
