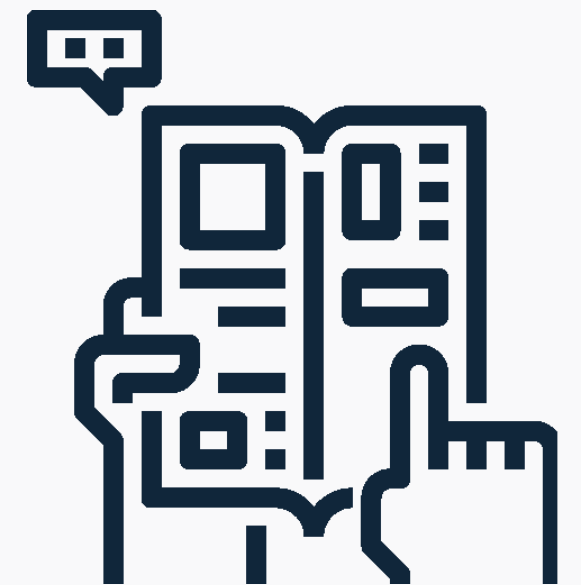

# GS Statement Review Required

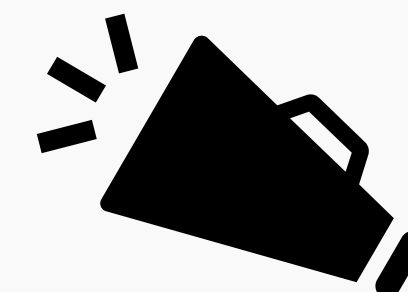


Effective immediately,

All **offshore** applicants (excluding Japan) will be required to have their **Genuine Student (GS) Statement** reviewed by Albright Institute **prior to the issuance of the CoE**.

Please note the following key points:

- The **GS Statement is NOT required at the LOO stage**
- However, it must be submitted and approved by Albright **before CoE issuance**
- The **CoE will only be issued once the GS Statement meets Albright's internal requirements**

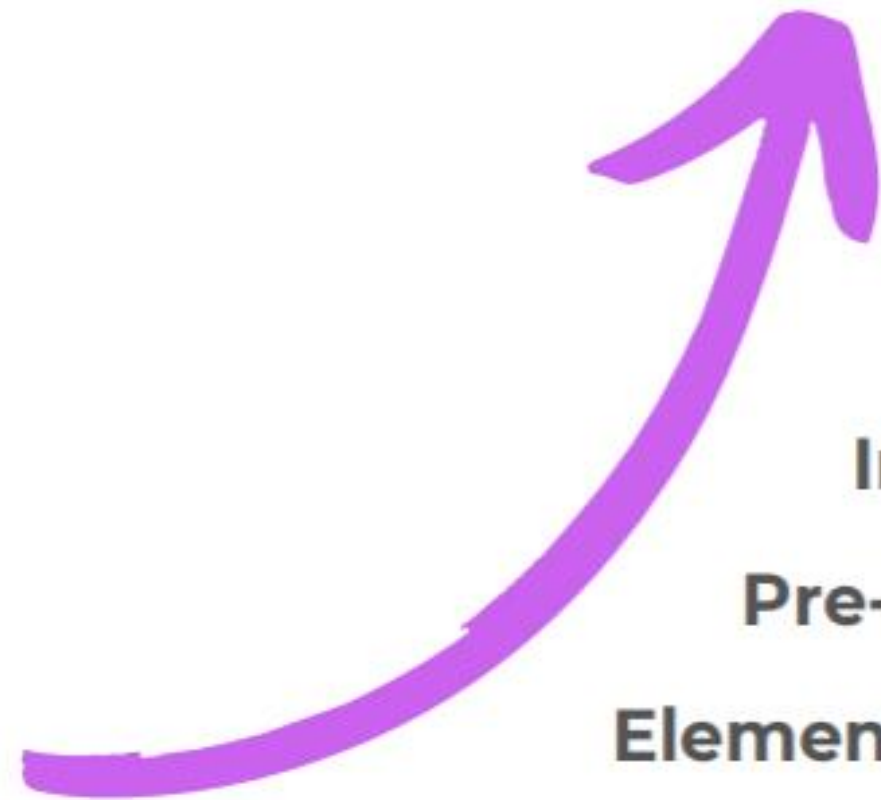

**A: 90%+ Attendance, Minimum 65% course progress** in each Skill (Reading, Writing, Listening & Speaking), 10 weeks at current level

**Certificate of Attainment**

**B: Between 89% to 80% Attendance, Minimum 65% course progress** in each Skill (Reading, Writing, Listening & Speaking), 10 weeks at current level

**C: Between 89% to 80% Attendance, Minimum 60% course progress** in each Skill (Reading, Writing, Listening & Speaking), 10 weeks at the current level

# Genuine Students



A **Genuine Student** is considered a genuine temporary entrant to Australia for the purpose of study as defined by the Department of Home Affairs.

- Meet Attendance course requirements - minimum of 80% timetabled classes.
- Making satisfactory progress toward completing the course

## Government Concerns:

- Growth in the sector needs to be promoted through integrity and quality, and students and graduates need to be better supported to realize their economic potential in the labor market.
- Integrity measures” to improve standards in the sector for both providers and students, while reportedly making sure graduates “do not become ‘permanently temporary’

# Albright examples of Non-Genuine Students



- Students who **do not commence studies**
- Students who do not attend classes;  
**4 Days per week ELICOS**  
**2 Days per week VET**
- Students who **do not demonstrate course progression.**
- Students who **take study breaks during ELICOS courses,** displaying no course progression, and breaking COE's.





# General English

## Focus on genuine student recruitment

### New students

- Only 1 COE per course
- General English enrolment in 10 weeks Blocks accepted

### Current students

Only **1 COE per course** = If the student requires an extension on the same course:

- Student needs to communicate the intention to extend the course **before current COE expires**
- **Academic Advise** based on student's academic background in Albright (duration of the course extension)
- **GAPS ARE NOT ALLOWED** for the same course
