Conditions:

- *Course Fees included Enrolment fee, course fee, material fee, weekend activities fee, T-shirt and a GoCard
- *Students are required to hold an Australian mobile phone number
- *Weekday activities, including the morning briefing, are offered from 9:00am to 11:30am, and Junior Holiday English classes (including breaks) are held from 12:30pm to 4:00pm, Monday to Friday, except on public holidays.
- *Homestay service only available for student age 12+
- *Arrival to homestay and departure from homestay is Sunday to Sunday (to join the Saturday activity)
- *For students who start the program on 18 January, Homestay service is available from 16 January 2027. Students who finish on 6 February, Homestay service available to 7 February 2027
- *It is compulsory for all Under 18 students staying with Langports Homestay Family to book a return airport transfer (Pick-up + Drop-Off)
- *All meals covered
- *Langports accommodations are not available for parents
- *During the peak season, Homestay may host more than one student, placements with similar backgrounds may occur when necessary
- *A guardian/parent per a student
- *Total enrolment weeks must be same or less the enrolment weeks of child
