English lessons

- 8:30AM to 12:20PM, Mon-Fri (Classes may be taught in the afternoon)
- Academic focus on speaking, listening, vocabulary, and pronunciation, with additional emphasis on grammar reading, and writing
- LSI certificate on completion of the programme

Meals

- Breakfast from host (cereal, toast, fruit, juice and tea or coffee)
- Packed lunch daily (sandwich, fruit and drink)
- Home-cooked dinner
- Dietary needs: advise at booking. Additional fee for dairy, gluten free, and/or nut free diets.

Accommodation

- **Homestay:** Single rooms (very few twin rooms available) with shared bathrooms
- Bed linen, towels, Wi-Fi
- Weekly laundry (1 load)
- 9:00 PM curfew nightly (6:00 PM for under 16s)

Transport

- Homestays are typically within an easy commute of the school, with 2 students placed together where possible so they can travel together
- Students are taken to the activities by LSI staff. Following the activities, the groups may be brought back to school or approved independent return home is permitted with prior parental consent
- Travel cards can be included in the package

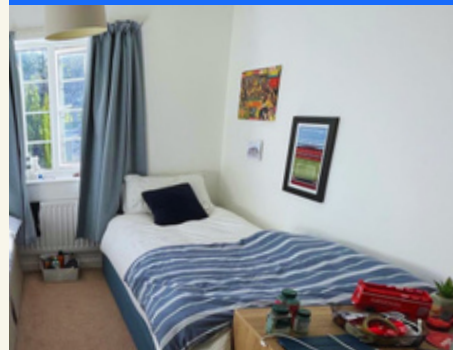

Supervision on Activities Programmes: Information for Students and Parents

Supervision for students is provided by our teachers and activities leaders during travel to activities and while participating in activities

Afternoon Activities:

Students will travel back to the residence with our activity leaders/teachers. Students who are on the homestay Junior programme will travel back to their homestay accommodation. Staff will ensure that the students are shown to the correct bus stops and will wait until all students have boarded the correct buses. Students will be asked to send a text to a designated member of staff informing them they have arrived home safely. The designated member of staff will also contact the homestays to make sure all students have arrived home.

Saturday Excursions:

For students on the homestay programme, staff will ensure that the students are shown to the correct bus stops and will wait until all students have boarded the correct buses following a Saturday excursion. Students will be asked to send a text to a designated member of staff informing them that they have arrived home safely. The designated member of staff will also contact the homestays to make sure all students have arrived home.

Free time:

Students on the residential programme will not be permitted to leave the site during free time at the weekends/evening unless accompanied by an activity leader/teacher. Students who are in groups will be able to go off site with their Group Leader with a planned activity after completing a risk assessment and signing out themselves and their students. Group Leaders/students will be required to sign back into the residence on their return.

LSI does not supervise students on the homestay programme during any scheduled free time in the afternoons, evenings or at the weekends. Students are not normally permitted to leave the school without the school's full permission. Note: parents cannot give unilateral permissions (i.e, the student is not free to leave LSI Brisbane until the school has approved this).
