## Programme Overview

### **Immerse yourself in a new culture, while learning English!**

The Demi Pair programme is an excellent opportunity for students to study the English language at Language Studies International (LSI) in Australia or New Zealand and live with a local family so you can experience a typical lifestyle at the same time.

Demi Pairs receive accommodation in a single room with three meals per day in the family home in exchange for 15-20 hours of childminding and household duties each week. The Demi Pair is required to have two days off per week, while it is preferred that these days are consecutive and on a weekend, this may not be an option. The host family and the Demi Pair will agree upon a work roster which will outline the Demi Pair's days off.

## What to Expect

The enriching cultural exchange is a wonderful experience for both the Demi Pair and the host family. The Demi Pair will be treated as part of the family and will further benefit by speaking English every day with the family, improving their own English language throughout the placement.

When deciding on arrival dates, please ensure that the Demi Pair arrives at least two days prior to the class starting date. The Demi Pair can start classes any Monday for General English and therefore it is recommended that the Demi Pair arrive either the Friday or Saturday before.

## Upon Arrival

On the first day of school the Demi Pair must arrive at 8:30am for placement testing and an orientation session. During their first week at LSI, our Demi Pair coordinator will have a private meeting with each new Demi Pair to clarify any questions, to assess the weekly work roster to ensure the work is balanced and fair. There will be regular meetings between the Demi Pair and LSI coordinator to ensure a successful placement.

## What if I don't like the family?

Students can move within the first month of starting their Demi Pair position – this is possible if the student or family are not happy. If this happens, the student is responsible for finding somewhere to live whilst a new family is found (LSI can assist at an additional cost). There is no guarantee of a new placement. A refund of the placement fee may be considered, depending on the circumstances for the placement not continuing. This is subject to the determination of the Demi Pair coordinators and based on the circumstances of each individual situation.
